*“Dance Out Loud”*

- All rehearsals will be held at the Sullivan Performing Arts Theatre on the Texas High School campus. Doors will not be open earlier than scheduled times.
- There will be no regular dance classes at the studio during recital week (June 4-7).
- Because the stage gets too crowded and noisy during rehearsals, all parents must stay either in the dressing room or in the audience during rehearsals.
- Do not wear costumes to or from the theatre for any reason. You may come to the theatre with hair and make-up ready.
- Please understand all rehearsals are mandatory and you cannot miss any scheduled rehearsal without permission by Ms. Joni.

### Rehearsal (Thursday, June 7<sup>th</sup>) 4:00pm-9:00pm

This will be an afternoon/evening rehearsal for recreational classes only. No team rehearsal. Students should wear class leotard, tights, have hair up, and bring all dance shoes. We will not wear costumes this afternoon. Schedule TBA.

### Technical Rehearsal (Friday, June 8<sup>rd</sup>) 4:00pm-9:00pm

This will be an afternoon/evening rehearsal for the dance team only. No recreational classes. This rehearsal includes full make-up and complete costumes. Schedule TBA.

### Dress Rehearsal (Saturday, June 9<sup>th</sup>) 9:00am-1:00pm

This will be a morning rehearsal for all dancers. Dress Rehearsal will also be run in recital order. This rehearsal includes full make-up and complete costumes

### Spring Recital (Saturday, June 9<sup>th</sup>) 6:00pm

Arrive at the theatre by 5:00pm.

- If your child is a 5<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, or 15<sup>th</sup> year dancer, please let the office know by April 20<sup>th</sup> so we can get a trophy ordered for them.
- Anyone receiving a trophy (for 5<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup> year) will practice on Saturday morning (at the beginning of Dress Rehearsal). Bring the person giving flowers if possible.
- All students will wear a recital t-shirt, black shorts, and ballet or jazz shoes to perform in the 'Finale'.
- You will be at the theatre for approximately 3-4 hours each time you come to a rehearsal. Practices are long but very rewarding. You may leave when we are through practicing all of your child's numbers and the 'Finale'.
- All rehearsals are subject to change slightly, if needed, due to the Theatre scheduling.

## Rehearsals

A parent must accompany each student during rehearsals at the theatre. If you are unable to attend a rehearsal, please have someone be responsible for your child. Mothers are responsible for dressing and undressing their own child at tech/dress rehearsal and the recital. Please know that there will be no men allowed in the dressing rooms, for any reason! If you bring food to theater you are responsible for disposing of it properly.

## Make-up

Make-up will be worn for pictures, tech rehearsal, dress rehearsal, and the recital performance. Applied correctly, make-up will enhance features so the student will not look "washed out" under the bright lights. Make-up should include eye liner, eye shadow (wine, blue, or green), blush, lipstick (red or pink), and mascara.

## Tights

Each student will be instructed on what color tights are to be worn for each dance number. The correct color tights are listed on the attached accessory list. Hand wash tights **ONE TIME ONLY**, and put away until recital.

## Recital T-Shirts

Each dancer will automatically have a t-shirt ordered for recital. If parents, siblings, etc. would also like a t-shirt, please see Ashley or Leslie in the office for the order form.

## Accessories

The only accessories to be worn at any time are those which are included with the costume. NO hair barrettes, earrings, necklaces, rings, bracelets, watches, nail polish, etc. Also, please see that your child does not wear panties with any costume. Please note: If your child gets her ears pierced before the recital, she will have to remove them for her performances.

## Recital Tickets

You will receive 2 free tickets to the recital per child. Each additional ticket above your 2 free will be \$10.00 each. Your child will have to have a ticket if they want to sit in the audience at any time. Tickets will go on sale a few weeks before the recital and will be first come, first serve. Sale dates TBA.

## Program Ads

If you would like to put an ad in the recital program for your child, those will be available Monday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>. All ads must be turned in by Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup>.
